Digital capabilities are at the heart of the company's success, and SMSA Express relies on its operational IT systems, email exchange server, ERP systems, SQL databases, and other customer-facing and business-critical applications 24/7. As a result, keeping these platforms running smoothly around the clock is a top priority for the organization's IT team.

In a fast-moving threat landscape, unplanned downtime is not the only risk that SMSA Express must guard against. With cyberattacks becoming more frequent and pernicious across many industries, the logistics leader decided it was time to step up its cyber resiliency efforts. Specifically, SMSA Express wanted to better protect its core data and systems and recover faster in the event of a ransomware attack.

While existing backup tools had helped SMSA Express keep its core data safe, managing the legacy environment was complex and time-consuming. Adding to the challenge was the fact that the company lacked the storage space to store multiple copies of its cloud and on-premises environments. Crucially, none of the backup tools supported military-grade 256-bit Advanced Encryption Standards (AES)—a new mandate from the company's information security team.

To support always-on availability and comply with the latest information security mandates, SMSA Express replaced its multiple backup solutions with the Commvault® Cloud cyber resiliency platform.

In addition to delivering a recovery time objective (RTO) of 4 hours and a recovery point objective (RPO) of 24 hours, Commvault Cloud has helped to reduce the total cost of ownership of its cyber resiliency infrastructure.



"Relying on multiple backup tools was expensive and complex" says Khalid. "By consolidating to Commvault, we have reduced the cost of cyber resiliency activities by 25 percent. What's more, we no longer have to log into different systems to manage our cyber resiliency and data security environment.
